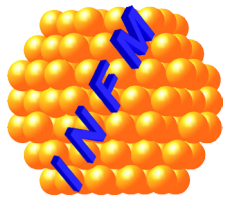

# D-EMERSYS

Rapid intervention force to chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear emergencies on the Danube River

Project Code: 15.3.1.052, e-MS code ROBG - 123

European Union contribution: 5,061,214.79 Euro

The strategic project objective is to create within the structure of emergency authorities from the cross-border area, a joint rapid intervention force to CBRN emergencies on the Danube River. This joint intervention force will comprise of an on-the-water, specialized reaction unit (from Romania) and an on-the-land, support unit (from Bulgaria), which will be both provided with means for rapid deployment of respective technical facilities and intervention teams, and equipped with capabilities for toxic, hazardous substances' detection and for execution of decontamination and search- and-rescue activities.

The joint intervention force will rely on a joint intervention plan, harmonized operational procedures and skills of intervention personnel that will be delivered by the project, and will be furthermore complemented by specialized analyses on contaminants through the high-technical equipment that is provided for development of an “environmental forensic laboratory” within a national top research institution.
